EMERGENCY PROCEDURES 24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 734 607 IF THIS HAPPENS DO THIS Tanker/Vehicle Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Accident Call the emergency services: Dial 111 Spill or leak Do NOT touch or walk through spilled material. Wear PVC overalls, chemical resistant gloves, facemask or goggles. Stop leak when safe to do so. Prevent entry into waterways, drains, or confined areas. Adsorb spilled product and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal. Fire Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Combustible product at elevated temperatures. Decomposition products in a fire are toxic and or irritant. When fighting a major fire wear an air-supplied respirator. Wear protective equipment. Extinguish warehouse and factory fires using dry chemical, foam or CO2 extinguishing media. Cool sealed drums with water to prevent rupture due to thermal expansion. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away. **FIRST AID** If Swallowed DO NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately. If in Eyes Hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention. If on Skin If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Do not scrub the If Inhaled Remove patient to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-nose. Get medical attention if symptoms develop.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION

Storage: Keep out of reach of children. Keep in original containers and tightly closed. Keep away from food, drink and animal feeding stuffs. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated place and protect from sunlight. Avoid temperatures below minus10°C or above 35°C. Keep away from flames and hot surfaces

Aggregate Storage Volume Thresholds: When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For full details refer to the current NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals and the HSNO Regulations.
