MODE OF ACTION: The Ultraviolet (or UV) lamp in the Insect Light Trap uses the power of ultraviolet rays to lure flies and other unsuspecting flying insects into the trap. UV light disperses from the top, sides and front of the insect light trap. When the flies and other flying insects enter the Light Trap; they become entrapped on the adhesive surface of the glue board. The more they struggle to escape, the more strongly they get stuck to the adhesive on the glue board; eventually dying. The use of glue boards provide an environmentally friendly, discreet and sanitary way to control flies and other flying insects; without the use of potentially harmful and toxic chemicals.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- Tear and discard sections 1 and 2.
- Fold the board in half along the perforation
- Remove the protective paper from the glue board
- Carefully slide the board into the unit (insect lamp)
- Make sure it is held in place by the clips at the top of the unit.
- Re-fasten the 2 retaining clips at the bottom of the unit to ensure the glue board doesn't drop out.
- Use thermally resistant gloves.
- Wear coveralls and safety glasses or face shield to protect against spillage.
